Drainage Districts face many regulatory obligations that are difficult to meet with a small group of volunteer leaders. Let's look at ways the CCSWCD can assist and services that can be provided to ease those burdens.

Hunting and other concerns near drainage ditches will be addressed by Illinois Conservation Police Officers.

Also planned for the morning is a Regulatory Panel with Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, and the Army Corps of Engineers. They will answer some of the more common questions and you are welcome to bring your own questions.
