

Envirothon 2022 – Oral Presentation

Fifth Category: *Waste to Resources*

Scenario:

You and some of your fellow students had recently become interested in the ‘green movement’ and organized “The Green Glove Club” at the high school. Since organizing, the group has implemented a couple of environmental positive programs at your school. These include recycling and composting. You also have a new idea on the table.

Two City Council members, and alumni of the school, have heard very good things about the ‘Club’, and the school’s green movement. They have invited your Club members to the next City Council meeting and ask you to inform and sell the ‘green movement’ to the Council, with hopes they will become proactive and offer environmental positive programs to the residents. Knowing this information is very new to all but two City Council members, the Club will have a lot of education and information to present to the Council.

You should be prepared to present the following to the City Council:

- 1. Explain the ‘green’ activities that have started and the school.***
- 2. Explain how you got the School Board’s backing.***
- 3. Explain the short & long term benefits of your implemented programs.***
- 4. Introduce your newest idea you plan to get started at the school this Spring***

One school per county will be required to participate in the group presentation. If the school has one team, all five members of the team will be required to participate. If the school has 2 teams, members from both teams will be required to participate together.

The SWCD employee coordinating the Envirothon for their county will be responsible for selecting the team participating in the presentation. The presentation time will be 5-7 minutes and all team members will be expected to participate. Visual aids of the non-electronic type may be prepared prior to the Envirothon, and used for the presentation.
